Note-Orders issued by the MSPC contain a provision that the work shall be commenced within 18 months of the date of the issuance of the Order. If work is not commenced within such time period, the order shall expire, and the petitioner will need to file a new petition to pursue the work. Prior to the expiration of an order, one extension of time, not to exceed six months, may be sought from the MSPC Chair.
